The RR HOA Board discussed the Birchcrest Tree and Landscaping proposal to perform Lawn 2024 Lawn Chemical and Fertilization Care treatment work here at Rivers Run. We have approved and awarded a modified 2024 Tree and Landscaping Health care and Lawn Fertilization and Chemical treatment proposal.

Also attached is a copy of the Tree and Landscaping and Lawn and Tree Product Information guide. The products listed on the attached product documents may be selectively used or may not use at all. Birchcrest utilizes the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) guidelines and procedures when utilizing any product in our community. The IPM care program includes regular property inspections of our landscape plants and shrubs. These inspections are done by a trained technician who will apply treatment as needed using IPM techniques.

1. June and August Multipurpose Spray to be combined into one service done in July or August.

Note:

- The Disease Treatments (1-3) are a dormant oil fungicide to treat Blue and White Spruce trees and the other evergreen trees. The Blue and White spruce trees are very susceptible to needle cast, a fungal disease of spruce trees that causes needles to turn brown and fall off, which could damage the trees in just one season. The following are the RR Tree Map numbers of the spruce trees being treated: Tree Map # 18, 19, 62, 63, 64, 68, 102, 103, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, 119, 120, 121, 122, 123, 125, 127, 128, 133, 135, 136, 157
- We have decided to opt out of having the June Multipurpose spray done, however based on our discussion with Steve (Beaver) Bakowski we are requesting Birchcrest do a review of the property's trees and shrubs in the August time frame to determine the health of the trees and shrubs and report back to the HOA their findings and if need any additional care is needed.

Late Fall: Granular winterize fertilizer to entire lawn, wee control, post emergent crabgrass control and broadleaf weed control if needed.

Products being used for Tree and Lawn Treatments:

Products to be used on Lawn:

- 1. Dimension 0.10% Plus Fertilizer; Crab Grass Pre-emergent
- 2. Q4 Turf Herbicide; 18-0-3 Granular Fertilizer
- 3. Q4 Turf Herbicide or Three way weed control; (J) Duocide Insect Control (grub control only were needed); 18-0-3 fertilizer
- 4. (B) Q4 Turf herbicide or (C) Three-Way Selective Herbicide; Weed control plus 18-0-3 fertilizer

Product to be used on Tree & Shrubs:

- Fungicide for black spot; needle cast, various other diseases
 Product Propizol (systemic fungicide); Protect DF fungicide; Bayleton 50 fungicide;
- 2. Bifen/Sevin insecticide, treats many different insects i.e. Japanese Bettles, Spider mites and more.

Propizol: It is a systemic fungicide, so it will be absorbed into treated plants to prevent diseases as well as treat ongoing infections. Propiconazole is used in a number of different popular fungicide products to control fungi, bacteria, and viruses affecting plants.

Bayleton 50 is a systemic (acropetal penetrant) fungicide that is absorbed by roots. Its broad-spectrum activity and residual control make it easy to fight most turf diseases.

Protect DF is a dry flowable fungicide and is a coordination product of zinc ion and manganese ethylenebisdithiocarbamate which can be used on turf and ornamentals. Use Protect DF as a spray to provide both preventative and curative action for many plant diseases. When Protect DF is used as part of a regular protective spray program it can help to prevent disease before it occurs thereby reducing the overall usage of fungicide needed if disease were to strike.

Birchcrest provided us with the attached Chemical Labels for the Tree and Lawn treatment and a weather pending service schedule for the chemical and fertilization treatments (page 2 of bid). Remind them that our lawns are mowed on Monday and the contractor has asked that the treatments be done on Tuesday through Friday allowing at least 48 hours to elapse prior to the lawn crew's schedule work day.

Lawn Care Program Scope of Work

Early Spring: Fertilizer, weed control, broadleaf weed control, surface insect control and pre-emergence crabgrass control.

Late Spring: Slow-release fertilizer to the entire lawn to maximize growth, pre-emergent crabgrass control, broad-leaf weed control, grub/insect control

Summary-Early Fall: Fertilizer, weed control, spot weed control, post-emergent crabgrass control, grub/insect control, as needed
